

BARRY C. COSGROVE

Barry C. Cosgrove is an American business executive, attorney and charitable director who, for the past twenty five years, has successfully founded and led public and private enterprises. Cosgrove is Co-Owner of Blackmore Escrow, Inc.

Cosgrove is an original founder of DaVita, now the largest independent provider of kidney care in the United States. Previously Cosgrove held senior executive positions with the Kendall Company (now Covidien/Medtronic) and Total Pharmaceutical Care (now Apria).

More recently, Cosgrove has served as Chairman and CEO of Blackmore Partners, a private equity firm. Blackmore Partners holds investment interests in private health care entities and selected retail operations.

As a result of these professional experiences Cosgrove has worked repeatedly with escrow operations of large banking institutions and became troubled with the glaring absence of high quality, sophisticated, boutique escrow operations. Hence Blackmore Escrow was formed.
